

POST OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR RETINAL SURGERY

1. Start antibiotic drop 3 days before the surgery.
2. Keep patch on your eye for the night. Dr. Weber will remove the patch in the morning.
3. In the morning, you will be seen at Dr. Weber's office in Shirley. Bring your medications with you.
4. For the evening, rest and take pain medications as prescribed by Dr. Weber.
5. Make sure you maintain the head position as instructed by Dr. Weber.
6. If you note fever or severe pain, call Dr. Weber's office and her service will page her.
7. Activities should be restricted to quiet activities only for 3 months.
8. You may eat a normal diet.
9. You may resume taking showers 1 day after surgery.
10. Keep the eye patched for 1 week. Use a clean patch daily.
11. Ask Dr. Weber about flying in an airplane after surgery.

POST OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR INTRAOCULAR INJECTIONS

1. Start the antibiotic drop 1 day before the procedure. Use the drop 4 times a day.
2. Bring the eye drop with you on the day of the procedure.
3. Fill the prescription for pain medication and take 1 pill the morning of the procedure.
4. Stop aspirin or blood thinners 3 days before the procedure if your medical doctor allows you.
5. Use the antibiotic drop 4 times a day, the day of the procedure, and 4 times a day the following day.
6. Call the office if there is increased pain, redness or decreased vision.
